

UPHA-14 TOURNAMENT RULES

ATTIRE: Jodpurs or breeches and boots; NO riding coats and NO derbies.
Helmets are **REQUIRED** for Junior Exhibitors 17 years of age and under and are strongly encouraged for adult riders.

MOUNT: Must be a horse that is used in a lesson program.

Riders may not cross-enter between levels.

Once a rider has shown off the lead, he/she may not return to leadline classes. Once a rider has shown at the canter, he/she may not return to walk-trot classes.

Horses may show in a full bridle, pelham or snaffle with martingale. Horses may be braided if desired. Tails may be braided or loose.

No farm names may appear on any exhibitor in the show ring.

In the Intermediate Workout class, the judge will select from the NEHC Saddle Seat Medal tests A or B. In the Advanced Workout class, the judge will choose from all the USEF tests. Workouts will be posted the morning of the tournament.

****LEVELS****

Tournament Level: Rider has never shown before other than UPHA Winter Tournaments.

Intermediate Level: Rider has shown in a full suit at one-day shows or the Academy division only.

Advanced Level: Rider has shown in a full suit at USEF rated shows or multiple day shows.

***Exceptions:** Intermediate and Advanced Workout classes

(Note: A rider who has shown at multiple day shows, but not in equitation, may show in the Advanced level on the rail and the Intermediate level workout.)
